

Review of graduate student Coastal Engineering research papers

Each CE A476 student is required to read at least two of the graduate papers and to provide comments via Discussion Board by 22 April 2016. Comments that are not in keeping with netiquette will be deleted and no credit given. The following questions are provided as guidelines for you to provide polite, constructive comments on the paper you chose to read.

1. What attracted you to read this paper?
2. Does the abstract summarize the content of the paper?
3. Does the introduction explain incentive and purpose?
4. Are you able to recognize efforts of others (references) that led to the author's analysis?
5. Do you understand the analysis? Does it seem complete and accurate?
6. Do you think the author uncovered useful points for application in engineering practice?
7. Do you agree with the conclusions? Can you add any of your own on this topic, based on information in the paper or your other personal knowledge or experience?
